RULES, REGULATIONS & PRIZING - COLD LAKE AG SOCIETY

1. Entries can only be registered on official AGFair2020 entry forms or emailed to manager@coldlakeag.com after registering online at coldlakeag.com

Emailed entries must include In the Subject Line:

Full Name | Section | Class | Name of Exhibit

ie. John Smith | AAA | 1 | Cool Beans

Every entry is to be sent as its own email - 10 entries = 10 separate emails.

Photo attachments must not include frames or exceed 4000 kb.

2. Online registration is encouraged, however in-person registration is available every Thursday at the Cold Lake Farmers' Market from 3:30pm-6:30pm **until August 20, 2020**
3. Upon Registration participants will receive an Exhibitor Number & (tags for drop-off entries)
4. Registrants may submit up to 10 entries into the various AGFAIR Categories.
5. **Sections:** ie. **(A)** Adult (17+), **(AA)** Youth (11-16) & **(AAA)** Novice (10 & under)
6. **Fees:** \$10 Adult and \$5 Youth, \$5 Novice
7. Youth & Novice may enter Adult Sections (A). List (AA) for Youth & (AAA) for Novice
8. Exhibitor#, Section, Class# & Name of Exhibit must be correctly indicated on all tags.
9. Emailed entries are exempt of physical tags and will receive social #tags online instead.
10. Only 1 entry is allowed per section and class per registrant. ie. A1 - Beans
11. Exhibits must be fresh, clean and original pieces of work - not copies of another artist.
12. No exhibits will be accepted online or in-person after the above stated drop-off times.
13. Registrants accept photos of their work will be shared online for #AGFAIR2020 promotion.
14. Doors are closed to the public during judging.
15. Judges may withhold or lower prize place if in their opinion entries are not worthy of 1st, 2nd or 3rd. Ribbons and comments from the judges will be awarded to winning entries.
16. Winning entries will be announced online and visible to the public Saturday.
17. It is the winners responsibility to claim their prize money at the AGFAIR2020 table August 29, 2020, (9am-4pm) or they forfeit the winnings. Exhibit Claim Check or Photo ID required.
18. **Prize monies:** 1st = \$5, 2nd = \$3, 3rd = \$2, People's Choice = Mix Prize Pack
19. The Cold Lake Ag Society will not be held responsible for any lost or damaged exhibits.
20. Exhibit pick-up is 9am-4pm Saturday. Those not picked up will be disposed of at 4pm.
21. Upon payment for registration each participant acknowledges that they and all of their entries are subject to the rules and regulations outlined in this document.
